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A BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To repeal Rota Local Law 13-3, which imposed a complete ban on the exportation of Raw Bayogo from the island of Rota.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE. The 23rd Rota Legislative 1 2 Delegation finds that the imposition of a complete ban on Bayogo export from 3 Rota has economically outgrown its purpose in making certain that the Bayogo from Rota is not exploited to enrich others by excluding Rota Bayogo crafts in the 4 5 markets accessible to tourists. The ban has gone through several economic changes and actually became a detriment to the people of Rota by not having the 6 7 opportunity to export raw Bayogo to sustain their livelihoods during economic 8 crises in the CNMI. 9 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to repeal Rota Local Law 13-3 and

lift the ban so that people from Rota can begin to explore economic opportunities

by either exporting raw Bayogo or venturing into crafting and exporting their

- 1 crafts through online marketing or other avenues.
- 2 SECTION 2. Repealer. Rota Local Law 13-3, codified under Title 10, Division
- 3 1, Chapter 1, Article 4, of the Commonwealth Code, is hereby repealed in its
- 4 entirety.

5 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

- 6 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
- 7 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
- 8 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
- 9 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
- 10 thereby.

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11 SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
- 13 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 14 repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes.
- 15 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
- 16 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
- 17 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
- already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 20 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its
- 21 becoming law without such approval.
