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**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate Two Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars and fifteen cents (\$267,269.15) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-23, specifically under Business Unit 3753L; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT  
DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

**1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2           The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Two Hundred Sixty-Seven  
3 Thousand, Two Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars and fifteen cents (\$267,269.15)  
4 allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-23, specifically under Business Unit 3753L.

**5 SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.**

6           Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the  
7 contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-  
8 appropriates Two Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Sixty-Nine  
9 Dollars and fifteen cents (\$267,269.15) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-23,

1 specifically under Business Unit 3753L, for the construction, renovation and/or  
2 repair of speed bumps, bus shelters, restroom facilities, basketball court facilities,  
3 street lights, traffic signs and road improvement projects within Precinct III.

4 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

5 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall be  
6 the Secretary of the Department of the Department of Public Works.

7 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.**

8 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds  
9 appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

10 **SECTION 5. REPORTING.**

11 The expenditure authority shall submit to the Chairperson of the Saipan and  
12 Northern Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of  
13 the funds at the completion of appropriations in Section 2 of this Act.

14 **SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

15 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed  
16 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

17 **SECTION 7. FISCAL YEAR.**

18 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

19 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.**

20 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any  
21 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,

1 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
2 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected  
3 thereby.

4 **SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


5 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as  
6 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
7 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers  
8 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to  
9 prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in  
10 any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in  
11 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


12 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**
