A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To allow for re-programming of funds previously appropriated by Rota Local Law 23-01 to facilitate the renovation of the Rota Guest House Facility in Fina Sisu.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF

THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to reappropriate funds originally appropriated by RLL 23-01 to allow the Municipality of Rota via the Mayor of Rota to reprogram up to \$40,000.00 from the funds already appropriated to the First Senatorial District that have been identified by the Commonwealth Economic Development Authority as available for appropriation to facilitate the renovation of the Rota Guest House Facility in Fina Sisu.

1	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION AND REPROGRAMMING AUTHORITY.
2	Notwithstanding any provisions of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the
3	contrary, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby authorizes the appropriation and
4	reprogramming of \$40,000.00 of the Earned Bond Interest Income collected for the
5	First Senatorial District, that has been identified by the Commonwealth Economic
6	Development Authority as available for appropriation and already appropriated by
7	Rota Local Law 23-01.
8	SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
9	The expenditure authority of the funds appropriated in Section 2 shall be
10	the Mayor of Rota.

1 SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

9 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming11 law without such approval.
