A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars
- 3 (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05, \$108(C), which was line-item vetoed. The
- 4 Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation recognizes Governor Palacios' veto message.
- 5 Accordingly, the Delegation seeks to appropriate the \$20,000.00, which is from the Tinian Casino
- 6 License fees that are not part of the general fund. This appropriation of local funds is not part of
- 7 the FY 2024 Budget Act. Therefore, this local appropriation of local funds does not contravene 1
- 8 CMC § 7401 and 1 CMC § 7204(d) or any other provision of the CNMI Budget Act.
- 9 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

HOUSE LOCAL BILL 23-34, D1

Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules, or regulations to the contrary, the
Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates Twenty Thousand Dollars
(\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05, §108(C) to the following:
(a) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for the
discretionary account.
(b) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to the Tinian Municipal Council for operations.
SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
(a) The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2(a) shall be the Mayor of Tinian
and Aguiguan.
(b) The funds under Section 2(b) shall be divided and distributed equally to the separate
accounts of each member of the Tinian Municipal Council. Each Municipal Council member shall
be the expenditure authority of the funds distributed to the respective separate accounts.
SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.
If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act
or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held
invalid shall not be affected thereby.
SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.
This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing
right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or
order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding

- 1 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
- 2 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
- 3 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
- 4 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without
- 6 such approval.
