### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$94,091.00 for the personnel and operations of the Tinian Casino Gaming Control Commission.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

### SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate, pursuant to 10 CMC § 2581, Ninety-Four Thousand Ninety-One dollars (\$94,091.00 USD) of local revenue for the personnel and operations of the Tinian Casino Gaming Control Commission. The certification of funds was prepared on August 27, 2024, and was reviewed and confirmed by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer.

### **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.**

Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Second Senatorial District from local revenue, the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates \$94,091.00 of the revenues collected for the Second Senatorial District as follows:

(A) \$80,000.00 to the Tinian Casino Gaming Control Commission for personnel; and

(B) \$14,091.00 to the Tinian Casino Gaming Control Commission for operational expenses.

### **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2 shall be the Chairman of the Tinian Casino Gaming Control Commission and/or his designee.

### SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.

Funds appropriated under this Act may be reprogrammed as needed and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

### **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

### SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in

1 existence on the date this Act becomes effective. 2 **SECTION 7.
