No. 23-30: To impose an additional five percent (5%) on any licensed construction contractor that earns a yearly gross revenue of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) or more for a period of three years. H. C. R. No. 23-1: To approve revenues and resources of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, as identified pursuant to Article III, Section 9(a) of the Constitution, as amended, and 1 CMC, Division 7, for Fiscal Year 2023, effective upon the passage of this resolution, and ending on September 30, 2023 to reflect proposed revisions to the FY 2023 Annual Appropriations Act enacted as Public Law 22-22. Introduced by REP. RALPH N. YUMUL of Saipan, Precinct 3 (*for himself*, Representatives Blas Jonathan "BJ" T. Attao, Angelo A. Camacho, Diego V. F. Camacho, Joel C. Camacho, Thomas J. DIC.
