A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend P.L. 16-10 section 2 to allow for the construction of a regulation basketball court and volleyball court

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TWENTY SECOND NORTHERN MARIAMNAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 **Section 1. Findings and Purpose.** The Legislature finds that P.L. 16-10
2 should be amended to allow for the construction of a regulation basketball court
3 and volleyball court in addition to the other necessary projects.

4 **Section 2. Amendment.** Public Law 16-10 section 2, is hereby amended
5 to read as follows: on page 4, line 3, after the word, “repairs” and before the “and”
6 add: “the construction of a regulation basketball court and volleyball court.”.

7 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of
8 any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court
9 of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its
10 provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid
11 shall not be affected thereby.


12 **Section 4. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein
13 shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or
14 acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted


1 under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding
2 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have
3 the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability civil or criminal,
4 which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

5 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by
6 the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
