A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend 3 CMC §2822(f) to rename the Commonwealth Health Center on Saipan as the Dr. Carlos S. Camacho Commonwealth Health Center.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 22ND NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1	Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature finds that there are
2	individuals who have tirelessly devoted their lives to public service. Dr. Carlos S.
3	Camacho has served the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands with
4	professional excellence and has made significant contributions to the quality of life
5	for our citizens, notably serving as the first Governor of the CNMI. Through his
6	tireless leadership, and the impact that he has left on the Commonwealth, it is
7	appropriate to re-name the Commonwealth Health Center on Saipan in his honor
8	for his time honored legacy of dedication, enthusiasm and outstanding public
9	service given to the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
10	Section 2. Amendment. Title 3, Division 2, Chapter 9, § 2822 (f) of the
11	Commonwealth Code is hereby amended as follows:
12	" § 2822. Definitions.

1	As used in this chapter:
2	(a) "Trustee" means the Board of Trustees of the Commonwealth
3	Healthcare Corporation established pursuant to this Chapter.
4	(b) "Chief Executive Officer" means a professional person with the
5	education and experience in Healthcare Management hired by the Board
6	of Trustess as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to manage the
7	Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation in the Commonwealth.
8	(c) "Clinics" means the Tinian Health Center, Rota Health Center, the
9	Women's Clinic and the Children's Clinic and other related public health
0	facilities providing healthcare and medical services in the Commonwealth.
11	(d) "Corporation" means the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation
2	established pursuant to this Chapter.
3	(e) "Health care professionals" means doctors, nurses, and those persons
4	licensed or certified to practice in the Commonwealth.
5	(f) "Hospital" means the Dr. Carlos S. Camacho Commonwealth Health
6	Center on Saipan, and such ancillary public health facilities as may from
7	time to time be established in the Commonwealth."
8	Section 4. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application of
9	any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court
0.0	of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its

- provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid
 shall not be affected thereby.
- 3 Section 5. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein
- 4 shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or
- 5 acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted
- 6 under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding
- 7 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have
- 8 the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal,
- 9 which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
- 10 Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by
- 11 the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
