## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate Three Hundred Eighty Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Thirty-Three Cents (\$380,529.33) generated under 4 CMC §53036; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE 23<sup>RD</sup> NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature finds that pursuant to 4 CMC §53036, the Commonwealth Cannabis Commission is able to assess 2 3 different types of license fees and application fees. However, pursuant to subsection (g) of the specified statute, such fees shall be placed in an account 4 5 separate from the general fund to pay the expenses necessary for the operation on the Commission subject to appropriation by the legislature. Such account is under 6 the expenditure authority of the Chairman of the Commission or his/her designee. 7 8 Cognizant of the Commission's urgent need for funds, the Legislature finds that it 9 is pertinent to exercise their power to appropriate those funds to allow for the Commission to continue their day-to-day operations in regulating the 10 11 Commonwealth's Cannabis Industry.

| 0  | Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of           |
| 1  | any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court    |
| 2  | of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its        |
| 3  | provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid   |
| 4  | shall not be affected thereby.  |
| 5  | Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein                 |
| 6  | shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or     |
| 7  | acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted      |
| 8  | under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding   |
| 9  | instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have    |
| 20 | the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, |
| 1  | which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective            |

- Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect 180 days after its
- 2 approval by the Governor or becoming law without such approval.
