He was admitted 8 to practice law in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the State of 9 Kansas, the U.S. District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands, and the U.S. Ninth 10 Circuit Court of Appeals; and 11 WHEREAS, the Honorable Pedro Manglona Atalig furthered his education by 12 attending and completing various training seminars in the following areas: legal writing 13 in plain English, criminal defense school, negotiation, college of advocacy, general 14 jurisdiction, appellate judges seminar, mediation and alternative dispute resolution, and 15 logic for lawyers and judges; and 16 WHEREAS, the Honorable Pedro Manglona Atalig began his distinguished legal 17 career in the CNMI as the assistant District Attorney for the Marianas from 1975-1976.

Subsequently, he was the assistant director for Public Administration for the Office of
