
**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$50,000 from the fees collected pursuant to Saipan Local Law 11-2, as amended by Saipan Local Law 13-8, for the construction and equipment of a Kannat Tabla Basketball Court Facility.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **Section 1. Findings and Purpose.** The Third Senatorial District Delegation
2 "Delegation") finds that the village of Kannat Tabla lacks a recreational facility. The
3 Delegation further finds that the residents of Kannat Tabla require a basketball court,
4 which is a facility that could be used for sports activities as well as community events
5 and social gatherings. The purpose of this appropriation is for the construction and
6 equipment of a Kannat Tabla basketball court facility.

7 **Section 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the amount of fifty
8 thousand dollars (\$50,000) from the fees collected pursuant to Saipan Local Law 11-2,
9 as amended by Saipan Local Law 13-8, for the construction and equipment of a Kannat
10 Tabla basketball court facility. The basketball court facility shall include a court with a
11 basketball net and ball, fencing around the court, bleachers and shelters for the
12 bleachers on two sides of the court, a restroom, and other amenities necessary for the
13 operation of the basketball court.

14 **Section 3. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority of the funds
15 appropriated in Section 2 of this Act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Public
16 Works.

17 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of any
18 such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of

1 competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to
2 persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
3 thereby.

4 **Section 5. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not
5 be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under
6 statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
7 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
8 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating,
9 or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
10 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

11 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
12 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.
