**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate the CIP Bonds Accrued Interest Income collected for the Third Senatorial District in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Sixty-Eight dollars and Fifty cents (\$195,468.50).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE

COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the CIP Bonds Accrued Interest
3 Income collected for the Third Senatorial District in the amount of One Hundred
4 Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Sixty-Eight dollars and Fifty cents
5 (\$195,468.50) that has been identified by the Commonwealth Development
6 Authority as available for appropriation.

7 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

8 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Saipan and
9 Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates the CIP Bonds
10 Accrued Interest Income collected for the Third Senatorial District in the amount

1 of One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Sixty-Eight dollars and
2 Fifty cents (\$195,468.50) that has been identified by the Commonwealth
3 Development Authority as available for appropriation for light installation(s) along
4 the pathway of Kagman Road beginning at Lao Lao Bay Golf & Resort and ending
5 on the intersection of Lalanghita Road and Pine Drive.

6 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

7 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall be
8 the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.

9 **SECTION 4. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

10 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed
11 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

12 **SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR.**

13 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

14 **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.**

15 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
16 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
17 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
18 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
19 thereby.

20 **SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

21 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as

1 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
2 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
3 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
4 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
5 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
6 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


7 **SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.**
