A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate funds specifically allotted to the First Senatorial District under Public Law 18-30, as amended; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate Eighty-Four Thousand Four
- 3 Hundred Fifty-Seven dollars (\$84,457.00 USD) of the funds specifically allotted to
- 4 the First Senatorial District under Public Law 18-30 as amended.

5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

- There is hereby appropriated Eighty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-
- 7 Seven dollars (\$84,457.00 USD) of the funds allotted to the First Senatorial District
- 8 under Public Law 18-30 as amended, to be expended by the Acting Secretary of
- 9 Finance for the Medical Subsistence Allowance for the Rota hemodialysis and
- 10 terminally-ill patients.

11 SECTION 3. NO REPROGRAMMING.

The funds allotted under Section 2 shall not be reprogrammed for any other 1 2 purpose. SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. 3 4 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, 5 6 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or 7 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby. 8 9 **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.** 10 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes 11 12 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. 13 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of 14 15 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective. 16 17 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. 18 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming 19 law without such approval.
