### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$148,920.00) from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301); and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

### 1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate One Hundred Forty-Eight
- 3 Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$148,920.00) from the Rota Municipal
- 4 Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301) and for
- 5 other purposes.

#### 6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

- Notwithstanding 10 CMC §1901, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby
- 8 appropriates One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars
- 9 (\$148,920.00) from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account

1	(specifically under Business Unit 2301) as follows:		
2	(a) One Hundred Eleven Thousand, Seven Hundred Eleven Dollars and		
3	Twenty-Six Cents (\$111,711.26) for the funding of parts of Rota Local Law		
4	20-10 (Specifically under BU 2312L, BU 2312M, and BU 2312N) to cover		
5	the shortfall in BU 3302. The Expenditure Authority shall be the Secretary		
6	of the Department of Finance; and		
7	(b) Thirty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Eight Dollars and Seventy-		
8	Four Cents (\$37,208.74) to the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation for		
9	the student housing assistance. The Expenditure Authority shall be the		
10	Chairman of the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Board.		
11	SECTION 3. FISCAL YEAR		
12	The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s)		
13	SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.		
14	If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any		
15	person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction		
16	the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons o		
17	circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected		
18	thereby.		
19	SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.		
20	This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed a		
21	affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statute		

- repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. 1
- Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or 2
- pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of 3
- terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall 4
- already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective. 5
- SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. 6
- This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming 7
- law without such approval. 8
