**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate the remaining balance of Twenty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$21,790.00) allotted under Section 2(d) of Saipan Local Law 20-19; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE

COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate the remaining balance of
3 Twenty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$21,790.00) allotted under
4 Section 2(d) of Saipan Local Law 20-19.

5 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATIONS.**

6 Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the
7 contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-
8 appropriates the remaining balance of Twenty-One Thousand Seven Hundred
9 Ninety Dollars (\$21,790.00) allotted under Section 2(d) of Saipan Local Law 20-

1 19 for the repair of the 2017 Ford F-550 Bucket Truck under the Office of the
2 Mayor of Saipan that was damaged during Super Typhoon Yutu.

3 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

4 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall be
5 the Mayor of Saipan.

6 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.**

7 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
8 appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

9 **SECTION 5. REPORTING.**

10 The expenditure authority shall submit to the Chairperson of the Saipan and
11 Northern Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of
12 the funds at the completion of appropriations in Section 2 of this Act.

13 **SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

14 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed
15 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

16 **SECTION 7. FISCAL YEAR.**

17 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

18 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.**

19 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
20 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
21 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or

1 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
2 thereby.

3 **SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


4 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
5 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
6 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
7 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
8 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
9 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
10 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


11 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

12 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming
13 law without such approval.
