A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To re-appropriate One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from Public Law 20-61, Section 2(c)(1)(A); and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.

- The Delegation finds that the Rota Roundhouse has been closed out to the
- 3 public for over a year as it has been condemned due to falling concrete. For years,
- 4 the Rota Roundhouse has been used as a gathering place for the community of
- 5 Rota. Since its condemnation, the people have resorted to outdoor venues which
- 6 are not always suitable due to weather and logistical concerns. Furthermore, the
- 7 funds appropriated under this Act shall be used to repair the building structure to
- 8 allow for the community to use such venue as a place of gathering for community
- 9 events, celebrations, and commemoration, among other uses.

The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate One Hundred Fifty Thousand

2	Dollars (\$150,000.00) from Public Law 20-61, Section 2(c)(1)(A) and for other
3	purposes.
4	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.
5	Notwithstanding 10 CMC §1901, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby
6	appropriates One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from Public Law
7	20-61, Section 2(c)(1)(A) for the renovation of the Rota Roundhouse.
8	SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
9	The Expenditure Authority for the funds under Section 2 shall be the Mayor
0	of the Municipality of Rota.
1	SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.
2	Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
3	appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.
4	SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR
5	The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).
6	SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.
7	If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
8	person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
9	the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
0.0	circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
1	thereby.

SECTION7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

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- This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
- 3 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 4 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
- 5 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
- 6 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
- 7 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
- 8 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

9 SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming
- 11 law without such approval.
