A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To amend Rota Local Law 21-3, Section 2(b) to re-distribute the original \$35,000 for DPS personnel to operations and to pay for any outstanding balance owed.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE  
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

2 The purpose of this act is to amend Rota Local Law 21-3, Section  
3 2(b) to re-distribute the original \$35,000 and expressly appropriate the sum of  
4 \$30,510 to the Rota DPS operations account and the sum of \$4,490 to CWM Travel  
5 for any outstanding balance owed.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.

7 Section 2(b) of Rota Local Law 21-3, is hereby amended to read as  
8 follows:

9 ~~“(b) \$35,000 to Rota DPS for personnel and pay for outstanding balance~~  
10 ~~owed to CWM Travel;~~

1           “(b) \$30,510 to Rota DPS for operations and \$4,490 to CWM Travel for  
2           outstanding balance owed;”

3           **SECTION 3. NO REPROGRAMMING.**

4           The funds allotted under Section 2 shall not be reprogrammed for any other  
5           purpose.

6           **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

7           If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any  
8           person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,  
9           the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
10          circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected  
11          thereby.

12          **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


13          This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as  
14          affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
15          repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.  
16          Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or  
17          pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of  
18          terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall  
19          already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

20          **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

21          This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming

1 law without such approval.
