# A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate funds specifically allotted to the Third Senatorial District under Public Law No. 20-59; and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE **COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

#### SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

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The Delegation finds that Public Law 20-59 reserved revenues from the 2 licensing of amusement machines within the Commonwealth of the Northern 3 Mariana Islands to pay back the Third Senatorial District for Within Grade Increase 4 (WGI) obligations of the Central Government to its civil service employees. The 5 Delegation further finds that the Central Government has already fulfilled its 6 7 obligation to the Second Senatorial District. Furthermore, the Delegation finds that the COVID-19 pandemic has greatly 8 affected the government's ability to provide essential services in addition to 9 employees of both the private and public sectors temporarily losing their jobs. The

1	Delegation additionally finds that many families are having a difficult time meeting
2	their obligations such as rental agreements. The Delegation finds that it is
3	imperative that it takes additional measures to assist its residents in these tough
4	times. The Delegation is cognizant of the fact that monies will be coming in from
5	the federal government but the Delegation believes that with the limited funds we
6	may have we need to take action in helping the residents of the Third Senatorial
7	District at the soonest until federal aid is available.
8	Therefore, the intent of this Act is to appropriate the funds allocated to the
9	Third Senatorial District under Public Law No. 20-59.
10	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.
11	Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the
12	contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby
13	appropriated One Million, Eight Thousand, Six Hundred Thirty Dollars
14	(\$1,008,630 USD) of the funds allotted to the Third Senatorial District under Public
15	Law No. 20-59 as follows;
16	(1) \$100,000.00 to Karidat to assist with its pan tree distribution for the
17	Residents of the Third Senatorial District;
18	(2) \$208,630.00 to the Northern Marianas College (NMC) for the Third
19	Senatorial District; expenditure authority shall be the President of NMC
20	or his/her designee;

1	(3) \$400,000.00 to the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation
2	(SNILD); expenditure authority shall be the Chairman of the Delegation
3	or his/her designee; and
4	(4) \$300,000.00 to the Northern Marianas Housing Corporation (NMHC)
5	to assist tenants and/or home loan program(s) within the Third
6	Senatorial District, provided that up to fifteen percent shall be reserved
7	for administrative cost associated with the implementation of this
8	program; expenditure authority shall be the Corporate Director of
9	NMHC of his/her designee.
0	SECTION 3. REPROGRAMING.
1	Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
2	appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.
3	SECTION 3. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.
4	The funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be transferred into
5	specific accounts. The Secretary of Finance shall regulate and control the funds
6	appropriated under this Act so that no activity may spend contrary to this Act or
7	fiscal management policies of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
8	Furthermore, unless specified in Section 2 of this Act the Secretary of the
9	Department of Finance shall be the expenditure authority of the funds.
0.0	SECTION 4. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
1	Unless specified in this Act the expenditure authority of the funds allocated under

Section 2 of this Act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance. Provided 1 2 further that the expenditure authorities under Sections 2 and 4 of this Act shall provide the Secretary of Finance and the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern 3 Islands Legislative Delegation or their respective designees of the expended funds 4 5 on a monthly basis. Failure to provide the Secretary of Finance and the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation or their respective 6 7 designees of the expenditures shall result of a seize of the distribution of any funds under this Act and any other future funds appropriated to the respective entities 8 9 until all information is submitted to the Secretary of Finance and the Chairperson 10 of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation. 11 SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR. The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal 12 13 year limitation(s). 14 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. 15 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, 16

the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or

circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected

- 1 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 2 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
- 3 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
- 4 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
- 5 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
- 6 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
- 7 SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 8 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming
- 9 law without such approval.
