**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) allotted under Tinian Local Law 20-15, Section 2(g) to the Office of the Mayor of Tinian & Aguiguan; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE
COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this act is to re-appropriate Forty Thousand Dollars
3 (\$40,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 20-15, Section 2(g) to the Office of
4 the Mayor of Tinian & Aguiguan for its operations and personnel activities.

5 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATIONS.**

6 Notwithstanding any provisions, statues, laws or regulations to the contrary,
7 the amount of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) appropriated under Section
8 2(g) of Tinian Local Law 20-15 is hereby re-appropriated to the Office of the Mayor
9 of Tinian & Aguiguan for its operations and personnel.

10 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY**

1 For the funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act, the Mayor of the
2 Municipality of Tinian and Aguiguan shall be the expenditure authority.

3 **SECTION 4. FISCAL YEAR.**

4 The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal
5 year limitation(s).

6 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

7 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
8 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
9 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
10 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
11 thereby.

12 **SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

13 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
14 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
15 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
16 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
17 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
18 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
19 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

20 **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


21 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming

1 law without such approval.


