**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate up to \$200,092.00 from the Second Senatorial District Developers Infrastructure Tax Fund under Business Unit 3731; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE

COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate up to \$200,092.00 of the funds
3 collected under the Developers Infrastructure Tax from the Second Senatorial
4 District under Business Unit 3731.

5 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.**

6 Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the
7 contrary, the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates up
8 to \$200,092.00 collected under the Developers Infrastructure Tax from the
9 Second Senatorial District under Business Unit 3731 as follows:

10 (a) \$200,092.00 for road improvement projects in Marpo Heights 3.

1 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

2 The expenditure authority for Section 2 shall be the Secretary of the
3 Department of Public Works.

4 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.**

5 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
6 appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

7 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

8 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
9 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
10 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to
11 persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be
12 affected thereby.

13 **SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


14 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
15 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
16 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
17 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
18 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
19 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
20 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

1 **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


2 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its
3 becoming law without such approval.
