### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$1,000,000.00 of the Casino License Fees collected for the Second Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 20-10; and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

#### 1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$1,000,000.00 collected for the
- 3 Second Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 20-10.
- 4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.
- Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to
- 6 the contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Second Senatorial District
- 7 pursuant to Public Law 20-10 \$1,000,000.00 shall be appropriated for personnel,
- 8 operations and municipal community programs.
- 9 SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
- The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 unless specified in
- 11 this Act shall be the Mayor of Tinian.

#### SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.

- Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other
- 3 purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under
- 4 this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

#### 5 SECTION 5. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.

- 6 (A) The Secretary of Finance shall regulate and control the expenditure of
- 7 the funds appropriated by this Act to ensure that appropriated funds are not
- 8 expended contrary to the law, fiscal management policies, and practices of the
- 9 Commonwealth.

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#### 10 SECTION 6. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.

- Expenditures of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be
- 12 responsible to report all expenses to the Secretary of the Department of Finance
- by the end of the 2021 calendar year. Provided further that failure to provide all
- 14 expenses entities that were afforded funds under this Act shall not be able to avail
- 15 to any future funds appropriated by the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative
- 16 Delegation.

#### 17 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY.

- 18 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
- 19 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
- 20 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to
- 21 persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be

1 affected thereby.

#### 2 SECTION 8. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- 3 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
- 4 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 5 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
- 6 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
- 7 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
- 8 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
- 9 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

#### 10 SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 11 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its
- 12 becoming law without such approval.
