A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate the sum of One Million dollars (1,000,000.00) from the exclusive gaming annual license fees allotted to the First Senatorial District under 4 CMC § 2307(a); and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the sum of One Million dollars
- 3 (\$1,000,000.00) from the exclusive gaming annual license fees allotted to the First
- 4 Senatorial District under 4 CMC § 2307(a) and for other purposes.

5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

- Notwithstanding 10 CMC §1901, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby
- 7 appropriates the sum of One Million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from the exclusive
- 8 gaming annual license fees allotted to the First Senatorial District under 4 CMC §

2	(a) Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for inter-island medical
3	referral stipend for patients and their escorts under the expenditure
4	authority of the CHCC CEO or his/her designee;
5	(b) Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for Medical Subsistence
6	Allowance for the Rota hemodialysis and terminally-ill patients under
7	the expenditure authority of the Secretary of Finance;
8	(c) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) to the Rota Liaison Office under
9	the expenditure authority of the Mayor of Rota;
10	a. Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) shall be used for vehicle
11	repair and maintenance;
12	b. Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) shall be used for fuel and
13	lubrication; and
14	c. Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) shall be used for offic
15	supplies and equipment.
16	(d) Fifty-Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be used to purchase a vehicle
17	for the Department of Public Safety-Rota Criminal Investigation
18	Division and for the cost of freight under the expenditure authority of
19	the Mayor of Rota;
20	(e) Five Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$535,000.00) for the Rot
21	Delegation (operations) under the joint expenditure authority of th

Chairpersons of the Delegation or their designee. 1 SECTION 3. FISCAL YEAR. 2 3 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s). 4 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. 5 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, 6 7 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected 8 9 thereby. 10 SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE. 11 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes 12 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. 13 14 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or 15 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall 16 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective. 17 18 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming 19 20 law without such approval.
