A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To re-appropriate Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Twenty cents (\$9,784.20) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-23; One Thousand One Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$1,149.20) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-19; and Twelve Dollars and Fifty-Five Cents (\$12.55) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-09; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Nine Thousand Seven
- 3 Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Twenty cents (\$9,784.20) allotted under Saipan
- 4 Local Law 19-23, specifically under Business Unit No. 3753W; One Thousand One
- 5 Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$1,149.20) allotted under Saipan
- 6 Local Law 19-19, specifically under Business Unit No. 7176J; and Twelve Dollars
- 7 and Fifty-Five Cents (\$12.55) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-09, specifically
- 8 under Business Unit No. 7180W.

SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATIONS.

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2	Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the
3	contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-
4	appropriates the amounts of Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars
5	and Twenty cents (\$9,784.20) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-23, specifically
6	under Business Unit No. 3753W; One Thousand One Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars
7	and Twenty Cents (\$1,149.20) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-19, specifically
8	under Business Unit No. 7176J; and Twelve Dollars and Fifty-Five Cents (\$12.55)
9	allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-09, specifically under Business Unit No.
10	7180W for the repainting of crosswalks in Kagman 3 and the installation of one
11	crosswalk within the Kagman High School Area.
12	SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
13	The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall be
14	the Secretary of the Department of Public Works or his/her designee.
15	SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.
16	Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
17	appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.
18	SECTION 5. REPORTING.
19	The expenditure authority shall submit to the Chairperson of the Saipan and

Northern Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of

the funds at the completion of appropriations in Section 2 of this Act.

SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.

- Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed
- 3 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

4 SECTION 7. FISCAL YEAR.

The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

6 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.

- 7 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
- 8 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
- 9 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
- 10 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
- 11 thereby.

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12 SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- 13 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
- 14 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 15 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
- 16 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
- 17 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
- 18 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
- 19 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

20 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming

1 law without such approval.
