**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate One Thousand, Sixteen Dollars (\$1,016.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-2, specifically under Business Unit 3400X; Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-2, specifically under Business Unit 3500A; Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-24, specifically under Business Unit 7177I; Thirteen Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$13,173.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-04, specifically under Business Unit 3754; Forty-Two Thousand, Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$42,059.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, specifically under Business Unit 7190B; and Seventy-Nine Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$79,171.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, specifically under Business Unit 7186X; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE

COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

2 The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate One Thousand Sixteen Dollars
3 (\$1,016.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-2, specifically under Business Unit
4 3400X; Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-2, specifically

1 under Business Unit 3500A; Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) allotted under
2 Saipan Local Law 19-24, specifically under Business Unit 7177I; Thirteen
3 Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$13,173.00) allotted under Saipan
4 Local Law 20-04, specifically under Business Unit 3754; Forty-Two Thousand,
5 Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$42,059.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26,
6 specifically under Business Unit 7190B; and Seventy-Nine Thousand, One
7 Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$79,171.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-
8 26, specifically under Business Unit 7186X. The figures listed above reflect fund
9 balances of completed projects within Precinct 1 that can be re-appropriated to
10 supplement existing projects and/or to fund new projects within the precinct.

11 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATIONS.**

12 Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the
13 contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-
14 appropriates One Thousand Sixteen Dollars (\$1,016.00) allotted under Saipan
15 Local Law 19-2, specifically under Business Unit 3400X; Twelve Dollars (\$12.00)
16 allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-2, specifically under Business Unit 3500A;
17 Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-24,
18 specifically under Business Unit 7177I; Thirteen Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-
19 Three Dollars (\$13,173.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-04, specifically
20 under Business Unit 3754; Forty-Two Thousand, Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$42,059.00)
21 allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, specifically under Business Unit 7190B;

1 and Seventy-Nine Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$79,171.00)
2 allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, specifically under Business Unit 7186X,
3 for a combined total of One Hundred Fifty-One Thousand, Four Hundred Thirty-
4 One Dollars (\$151,431.00), as follows:

5 (A) Fifty-Five Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars (\$55,232.00)
6 to supplement funds, appropriated under SLL19-8, Section 2(b), to
7 mitigate flooding at the intersection of Tun Thomas Sablan Road and
8 Batto Pl.; and

9 (B) Ninety-Six Thousand, One Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars (\$96,199.00)
10 for the construction, renovation, and/or repair of speed bumps, bus
11 shelters, restroom facilities, basketball court facilities and the
12 installation of street lights and traffic signage within Precinct 1, Saipan.

13 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

14 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall be
15 the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.

16 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.**

17 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
18 appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

19 **SECTION 5. REPORTING.**

1 The expenditure authority shall submit to the Chairperson of the Saipan and
2 Northern Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of
3 the funds at the completion of appropriations in Section 2 of this Act.

4 **SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

5 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed
6 accordingly to the intended purpose upon this Act becoming law.

7 **SECTION 7. FISCAL YEAR.**

8 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

9 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.**

10 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
11 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
12 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
13 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
14 thereby.

15 **SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

16 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
17 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
18 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
19 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
20 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
21 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall

1 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


2 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**
