A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301); and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- 2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate One Hundred Fifty Thousand
- dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve
- 4 Account (specifically under BU 2301) and for other purposes.

5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

- Notwithstanding 10 CMC §1901, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby
- 7 appropriates One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Rota
- 8 Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under Business
- 9 Unit 2301) as follows:

- 1 (a) One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) to the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation for student scholarships and housing assistance. 2 3 The Expenditure Authority shall be the Chairman of the Rota Municipal 4 Scholarship Foundation Board. 5 **SECTION 3. FISCAL YEAR** 6 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s). 7 **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.** 8 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any 9 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, 10 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or 11 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected 12 thereby. 13 SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE. 14 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as 15 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes 16 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. 17 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or 18 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of 19 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
