### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To re-appropriate Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05 and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

#### 1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Twenty Thousand Dollars
- 3 (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05, §108(C).

#### 4 SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.

- Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the
- 6 contrary, the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby re-appropriates
- 7 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05.
- 8 §108(C) to the following:
- 9 (1) Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the Mayor of Tinian and
- 10 Aguiguan for operations.

#### SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

- The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2 shall be the Mayor of
- 3 Tinian and Aguiguan.

#### 4 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

- 5 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
- 6 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
- 7 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
- 8 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
- 9 thereby.

#### 10 SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
- 12 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 13 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers
- 14 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to
- 15 prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in
- 16 any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
- 17 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

#### SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming
- 20 law without such approval.
