**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) allotted
under Tinian Local Law 23-05 and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT
DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF
THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Twenty Thousand Dollars
3 (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05, §108(C).

4 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.**

5 Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the
6 contrary, the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby re-appropriates
7 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) allotted under Tinian Local Law 23-05.
8 §108(C) to the following:

9 (1) Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the Mayor of Tinian and
10 Aguiguan for operations.

1 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

2 The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2 shall be the Mayor of
3 Tinian and Aguiguan.

4 **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

5 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
6 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
7 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
8 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
9 thereby.


10 **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


11 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
12 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
13 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers
14 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to
15 prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in
16 any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
17 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

18 **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

19 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming
20 law without such approval.
