**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate funds under Saipan Local Law 21-13; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE

COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 To reappropriate funds under Section 2(4) of Saipan Local Law 21-13 for
3 the payment of outstanding medical referral obligations to Saipan Employment
4 Agency & Services, Inc. (SEAS, Inc.) and to address road upgrades and the
5 construction in the Kagman area in Precinct V.

6 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.**

7 Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to
8 the contrary the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD)
9 hereby re-appropriates Three Hundred US Dollars (\$300,000.00) from Section
10 2(4) of Saipan Local Law 21-13 as follows:

1 A) \$60,000.00 for the payment of the outstanding medical referral
2 obligations to Saipan Employment Agency & Services, Inc. (SEAS,
3 Inc.), expenditure authority shall be the Secretary of the Department of
4 Finance or his/her designee; and

5 B) \$240,000.00 for road anti-skid on Chacha Rd. in Kagman I and for a
6 pounding basin in Kagman III; expenditure authority shall be the
7 Secretary of the Department of Public Works or his/her designee.

8 **SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.**

9 Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other
10 purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under
11 this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

12 **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

13 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
14 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
15 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to
16 persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be
17 affected thereby.

18 **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

19 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
20 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
21 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.

1 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
2 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
3 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
4 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

5 **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its
7 becoming law without such approval.
