# A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$348,000.00 from revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06; and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

#### 1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate local funds from the revenues

3 collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06.

# 4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

5 Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the 6 contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Third Senatorial District the Saipan 7 and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby appropriates 8 \$348,000.00 of the revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to 9 Saipan Local Law 22-06 as follows: (A) \$348,000.00 for the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation
 for but not limited to various projects within the Third Senatorial District,
 expenditure authority under 2(A) shall be the Chairperson of the Delegation or
 his/her designee.

#### 5 SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.

Funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other
purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this
Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

# 9 SECTION 4. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.

Expenditures of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be responsible to report all expenses to the Secretary of the Department of Finance by the end of the 2024 calendar year. Provided further that failure to provide all expenses, entities (Government, non-profits entities, etc... excluding specific projects) that were afforded funds under this Act shall not be able to avail to any future funds appropriated by the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

### 17 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

18 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any 19 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, 20 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or 21 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected 1 thereby.

#### 2 **SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

3 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as 4 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes 5 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers 6 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to 7 prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in 8 any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in 9 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

#### 10 **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming

12 law without such approval.
