## A LOCAL BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To amend Section 2(e) of Saipan Local Law 23-04 to ensure that the proper work order number is being funded.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

## 1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- 2 The purpose of this Act is to amend Section 2(e) of Saipan Local Law 23-
- 3 04 to ensure that the proper work order number is being funded.
- 4 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.
- 5 Section 2(e) of Saipan Local Law 23-04 is hereby amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 "(e) \$10,000.00 to complete the power pole distribution in Precinct 4,
- 8 Capitol Hill area under work order number 808329 808634."
- 9 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.
- If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any

- 1 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
- 2 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
- 3 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
- 4 thereby.

## SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE. 5

- 6 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
- 7 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
- 8 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers
- 9 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to
- 10 prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in
- 11 any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
- 12 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

## 13 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 14 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming
- 15 law without such approval.
