A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To re-appropriate One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, Section 2(r)(1), specifically under Business Unit 7190D.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- 2 The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate One Hundred Twenty Thousand
- 3 Dollars (\$120,000.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, Section 2(r)(1),
- 4 specifically under Business Unit 7190D.

5 SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.

- Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the
- 7 contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-
- 8 appropriates One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) allotted under
- 9 Saipan Local Law 20-26, Section 2(r)(1), specifically under Business Unit 7190D,

1	as follows:
2	(a) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the Office of the Special
3	Assistant for Youth Affairs for operations necessary to execute
4	community projects and initiatives in Precinct II;
5	(b) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the Office of Drugs and
6	Substance Abuse to administer the Substance Abuse, Addiction &
7	Rehabilitation (SAAR) Program, including funding operations
8	necessary to execute community projects and initiatives in Precinct II;
9	(c) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the Division of Corrections
10	to administer correctional programs affecting Precinct II, such as the
11	Department of Corrections (DOC) Outreach Program;
12	(d) Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) for the Division of Parks and
13	Recreation for the maintenance and improvements of Commonwealth
14	parks and recreational facilities in Precinct II.
15	SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
16	The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(a) of this Act shall
17	be the Special Assistant of the Office of Youth Affairs.
18	The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(b) of this Act shall
19	be the Special Assistant for Drugs and Substance Abuse.
20	The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(c) of this Act shall
21	he the Director of the Division of Corrections in consultation with the

1	Commissioner of the Department of Corrections.
2	The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(d) of this Act shall
3	be the Director of the Division of Parks and Recreation in consultation with the
4	Secretary of the Department of Lands and Natural Resources.
5	SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.
6	Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds
7	appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.
8	SECTION 5. REPORTING.
9	Expenditure authorities shall submit to the Chairperson of the Saipan and
10	Northern Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of
11	funds appropriated under this Act.
12	SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.
13	Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed for their
14	intended purposes and to the appropriate entities upon this Act becoming law.
15	SECTION 7. FISCAL YEAR.
16	The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).
17	SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.
18	If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
19	person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
20	the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
21	circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected

1 thereby.

2 SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
- 10 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without such approval.
