A LOCAL BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To amend Tinian Local Law 23-09; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- 2 The purpose of this Act is to amend Tinian Local Law 23-09 to allow for
- 3 the reprogramming of unspent funds allotted under TLL 23-09 to any of the projects
- listed under Section 2(a) to (d). 4

5 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.

- 6 Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the
- contrary, the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby amends Tinian 7
- 8 Local Law 23-09 as follows:
- 9 Section 4 is amended to read as follows:

10 "SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.

11 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions, or regulations to the contrary,

1	funds appropriated under this Act shall not unspent amounts allotted
2	under this Local Law may be reprogrammed for any other purpose to
3	other projects listed under Section 2(a) to (d)."
4	SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.
5	If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
6	person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
7	the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
8	circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
9	thereby.
0	SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE.
1	This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
2	affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
3	repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers
4	contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to
5	prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in
6	any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
7	existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
8	SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
9	This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming
0	law without such approval.
