**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$11,877.00 for the operations of the Mayor Tinian and Aguiguan pursuant to 10 CMC § 2581 and 1 CMC § 1405.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT  
DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

**1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE**

2       The purpose of this Act is to appropriate Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred  
3 Seventy-Seven dollars (\$11,877.00 USD) generated from local revenue pursuant to  
4 10 CMC § 2581 for operations under Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan. The  
5 certification of funds was prepared on January 21, 2025, and was reviewed and  
6 confirmed by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer

**7 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.**

8       Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the  
9 contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Second Senatorial District from local

1 revenue, the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates  
2 \$11,877.00 of the revenues collected for the Second Senatorial District as follows:

3 (A) \$11,877.00 to the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for operations.

4 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

5 The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2 shall be the Mayor of  
6 Tinian and Aguiguan.

7 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.**

8 Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other  
9 purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this  
10 Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

11 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

12 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any  
13 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,  
14 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or  
15 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected  
16 thereby.

17 **SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

18 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as  
19 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
20 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers  
21 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to



1 prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in  
2 any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in  
3 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

4 **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

5 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming  
6 law without such approval.




