A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$75,000.00 from revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate local funds from the revenues
- 3 collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06.

4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

- Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the
- 6 contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Third Senatorial District the Saipan
- 7 and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby appropriates
- 8 \$75,000.00 of the revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to
- 9 Saipan Local Law 22-06 as follows:

1	(A) \$75,000.00 for the CNMI Legislative Bureau for costs, expenses, and			
2	reimbursements, directly relating to the hosting of three events, to wit: 1) the 2025			
3	Association of Pacific Island Legislatures 65th Board of Directors Meeting on			
4	Saipan; 2) the 2025 Association of Pacific Island Legislatures 42 nd General			
5	Assembly Meeting on Saipan; and 3) the Third General Assembly of the Mariana			
6	Island Legislature Association Meeting on Saipan. The expenditure authority			
7	under 2(A) shall be the Legislative Bureau Director or his/her designee.			
8	SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.			
9	Funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other			
0	purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this			
1	Act shall be without fiscal year limitation. Provided further, to ensure continuity in			
2	administrative and operational planning, any unobligated balance remaining after			
13	the conclusion of events listed in Section 2(A) may be used by the Legislative			
4	Bureau for purposes consistent with its mandate.			
5	SECTION 4. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.			
.6	Expenditures of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be			
7	responsible to report all expenses to Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands			
. 8	Legislative Delegation. Provided further that failure to provide all expenses,			
9	entities that were afforded funds under this Act shall not be able to avail to any			
20	future funds appropriated by the Sainan and Northern Islands Legislative			

Delegation.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,

- 4 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
- 5 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
- 6 thereby.

7 SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- 8 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting
- 9 any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or
- under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained
- in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law.
- 12 The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way
- modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on
- the date this Act becomes effective.

15 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 16 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming
- 17 law without such approval.
