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**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate the remaining fund balance of \$50,411.00 under Saipan Local Law 21-10 (Project Code 7192H) for the maintenance, repairs and improvements of Commonwealth parks and recreational facilities in Precinct IV and for the purchase of base coarse to repair secondary roadways in Precinct IV; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION**

**PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE**

**COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2       The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the remaining fund balance of  
3 \$50,411.00 under Saipan Local Law 21-10 (Project Code 7192H) for the  
4 maintenance, repairs and improvements of Commonwealth parks and recreational  
5 facilities in Precinct IV and for the purchase of base coarse and the rental of  
6 necessary equipment to facilitate the repair of secondary roadways in Precinct IV  
7 and for other purposes.

8 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.**

9       Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to  
10 the contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Third Senatorial District the

Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby appropriates the remaining fund balance of \$50,411.00 under Saipan Local Law 21-10 (Project Code 7192H); as follows:

(a) Thirty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Eleven dollars (\$35,411.00) to the Division of Parks and Recreation for the maintenance, repairs and improvements of Commonwealth parks and recreational facilities in Precinct IV; and

(b) Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) to the Division of Roads and Grounds for the purchase of base coarse and the rental of necessary equipment to facilitate the repair of secondary roadways in Precinct IV.

**SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(a) shall be the Director of Parks and Recreation in consultation with the Secretary of the Department of Lands and Natural Resources and the expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(b) shall be the Director of Roads and Grounds in consultation with the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.

**SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.**

Notwithstanding any laws, provisions, or regulations to the contrary, funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

**SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR.**

The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year

1 limitation(s).

2 **SECTION 6. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.**

3 Expenditures of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be  
4 responsible to report all expenses to the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern  
5 Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of the  
6 funds. Provided further that failure to provide all expenses, entities that were  
7 afforded funds under this Act shall not be able to avail to any future funds  
8 appropriated by the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

9 **SECTION 7. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

10 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed  
11 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

12 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.**

13 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any  
14 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent  
15 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to  
16 persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be  
17 affected thereby.

18 **SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

19 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as  
20 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
21 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.

1 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or  
2 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of  
3 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall  
4 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


5 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its  
7 becoming law without such approval.
