A HOUSE RESOLUTION

To express a sincere and heartfelt congratulation to Senators Felix P. Camacho and Kaleo S. Moylan for successfully winning the Guam Gubernatorial and Lieutenant Gubernatorial Election held on Tuesday, November 5, 2002 and wishing them well during their term of office.

- 1 WHEREAS, Guam Election Law mandates that the Guam Gubernatorial and Lieutenant
2 Gubernatorial election be held on the first Tuesday in November every four years, and the team of who
3 receives 50 percent plus one vote of the total votes cast is declared the winner of the election; and
4 WHEREAS, the Republican Gubernatorial and Lieutenant Gubernatorial team of Senators
5 Felix P. Camacho and Kaleo S. Moylan garnered a total votes of 24,039, of 55% against the
6 Democratic Gubernatorial and Lieutenant Gubernatorial team of Congressman Robert A. Underwood
7 and Senator Thomas C. Ada who received 19,559 votes; and
8 WHEREAS, the Guam Election Commission on Friday, November 8, 2002 certified the
9 election results and officially declared the Republican Gubernatorial and Lieutenant Gubernatorial team
10 of Senators Felix P. Camacho and Kaleo S. Moylan the Guam Governor-elect and Lieutenant
11 Governor-elect; and
12 WHEREAS, the election of Governor-elect Felix P. Camacho and Lieutenant Governor-elect
13 Kaleo S. Moylan made political history in the Territory of Guam for being the first sons of a former
14 Governor and former Lieutenant Governor to be elected to the highest political posts; and

1 WHEREAS, Governor-elect Felix P. Camacho is the proud son of the first Governor of Guam,
2 the late Carlos G. Camacho and Lourdes P. Camacho and is married to Joann G. Camacho and blessed
3 with three children, Jessica Lourdes, Felix James and Maria Amparo; and

4 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Governor-elect Kaleo S. Moylan is the proud son of the first
5 Lieutenant Governor of Guam Kurt S. Moylan and Judith G. Moylan and together with Julie R. Cruz
6 has two children, Alyssa Lehua and Jada Pomaikai; and

7 WHEREAS, Governor-elect Felix P. Camacho was first elected and served as Senator in the
8 Twenty-Second, Twenty-Third, Twenty-Fourth and served as the Assistant Majority Leader and
9 Chairman of the Committee on Power, Governmental Operations and Foreign Affairs in addition to
10 serving as a member on several other committees, the Asian Pacific Parliamentarian Union, the
11 Association of Pacific Islands Legislatures, and National Council of State Legislatures, and in the
12 Twenty-Sixth Guam Legislature, served as Majority Whip and Chairman of the Committee on
13 Tourism, Transportation and Economic Development; and

14 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Governor-elect Kaleo S. Moylan was first elected and served as
15 Senator in the Twenty-Fifth and Twenty-Sixth Guam Legislature where he served as Chairman of the
16 Committee on Housing, General Government Services and Foreign Affairs and the Committee on
17 Ways and Means, and as Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, Senator Moylan led the
18 historic effort to cut more than \$94 million from the government budget forcing the government to live
19 within its means; and

20 WHEREAS, on Monday, January 6, 2003, Governor-elect Felix P. Camacho and Lieutenant
21 Governor-elect Kaleo S. Moylan will be sworn in as Guam's Seventh Governor and Lieutenant
22 Governor; and

23 WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives and people of the CNMI are
24 extremely proud of the election of Senators Felix P. Camacho and Kaleo S. Moylan as Guam's Seventh
25 Governor and Lieutenant Governor and wish them both success as they work toward building Guam's
26 economy and advancing the people of Guam; now, therefore

27 BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, Thirteenth NMI Commonwealth
28 Legislature, that the House hereby expresses a sincere and heartfelt recognition and congratulations to
29 Senators Felix P. Camacho and Kaleo S. Moylan for their successful election as Guam's Governor and
30 Lieutenant Governor; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall certify,
2 and the House Clerk shall attest to the adoption of this Resolution and thereafter transmit certified
3 copies to Honorable Juan N. Babauta, Governor, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands,
4 Honorable Paul A. Manglona, Senate President, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands,
5 Honorable Pedro A. Tenorio, Resident Representative to the United States; the Speaker of the
6 Twenty-Seventh Guam Legislature; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Speaker of the House shall present the certified
8 original copy to Governor-elect Felix P. Camacho and to Lieutenant Governor-elect Kaleo S. Moylan at
9 a time and date to be announced by the Speaker or his designee.
