A HOUSE RESOLUTION

Conveying the sincere condolences and sympathy of the House of Representatives of the Sixteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature to the bereaved family of the late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, on the occasion of his untimely passing and paying tribute to his services to the people of the Commonwealth and fond memory.

1	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano was born on January 29, 1939
2	to proud parents Jose Gusman Adriano and Magarita Gillimon Adriano and was called to his
3	eternal rest on January 22, 2009 at the age of 49; and
4	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, a loving husband, proud
5	grandfather, and devoted father to four beautiful children, namely Joaquin, Jr., Carlene
6	Yvonne, and Shane; and
7	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano graduated from Marianas High
8	School in 1978; and
9	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano studied Criminal Justice at
10	Northern Marianas College in 1979; and
11	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano has always sought to give to the
12	community, starting with his services in 1978 as a Police Officer I; and
13	WHEREAS, in 1984, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano served as Police
14	Sergeant Commander under the Division of Boating Safety of the Department of Public
15	Safety; and
16	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano as Police Captain was
17	transferred to the Department of Public Safety in Tinian as Operational Commander in 1987,
18	and

1	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, a man with great vision,
2	continued his services to the public as a member of the 4 th Tinian and Aguiguan Municipal
3	Council in the capacity of Chairman, facilitating and bravely pioneering the Second
4	Senatorial District into uncharted territory; and
5	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano provided aid to the residents of
6	the Commonwealth as the Precinct 5 Representative from 1994-1997, ensuring the growth of
7	the Commonwealth for years to come; and
8	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, a man with great vision, was
9	granted the vote of confidence by the residents of Tinian and Aguigan to represent them as
10	Senator in the 11 th , 12 th , 13 th , and 14 th Legislature in various capacities, creating constructive
11	legislation and tirelessly working towards the betterment of the people; and
12	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano served as the Legislative
13	Secretary of the 12 th Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature, Chairman of the
14	Committee on Federal Relations and Independent Agencies, and Chairman of the Tinian and
15	Aguiguan Legislative Delegation; and
16	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, a man with lasting enthusiasm,
17	was voted Floor Leader of the Senate by his colleagues in the 13th Commonwealth
18	Legislature, where he also served as the Chairman of Rules and Procedure, Chairman of
19	Executive Appointments and Government Investigations, Chairman of Federal Relations and
20	Independent Agencies, and Chairman of the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation;

22	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, a person with devotion, served
23	the people of the Commonwealth as President of the Senate in the 14 th Commonwealth
24	Legislature and as Secretary of the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation; and
25	WHEREAS, the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano retired from the CNMI
26	Government on January 10, 2006, but continued his pursuit of public service as he was
27	appointed by the Honorable Jose P. San Nicolas, Mayor of Tinian in 2008 as the official
28	representative to 702 negotiations (CIP Coordinator) under the covenant, until his untimely
29	passing; and
30	WHEREAS, it would be extremely difficult to find a person with similar compassion

and devotion to public service, like that of the Late Honorable Joaquin G. Adriano, a man
