The House of Representatives of the Twentieth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature convened its Second Day, First Special Session on Tuesday, May 1, 2018 at 1:51 p.m., in the House Chamber on Capitol Hill, Saipan, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

The Honorable Rafael S. Demapan, Speaker of the House, presided.

In the case of error of reference, correction may be made by the House, with debate, immediately after the reading and approval of the Journal, by unanimous consent, or upon motion of either committee claiming jurisdiction or the committee to which the measure has been erroneously referred.
- (b) The Speaker may place a resolution directly on the Resolution Calendar, rather than refer it to a committee, subject to appeal to the House.

Just to let the record reflect in the early 2006 I believe, a part of public land was already designated for the Palauan "Abai" in Navy Hill and since then there has not been any construction activity, however there has been negotiations between DCCA who the land was designated to and the Palauan community discussing the desire to relocate the designation of land. DCCA as the designee has drafted an agreement with DPL to relocate this property up here to Capitol Hill next to the former Retirement Fund building. Because of that they're now in the process where it's a intergovernmental designation between DPL and DCCA and this resolution is simply to support the

desires of the parties involved for DPL to approve and execute the new designation that would pave the way for the construction of the Abai house up here on Capitol Hill. Having said that Mr. Speaker, I would like to direct the members to ELMO to make a floor amendment on page 3, beginning on line 2 to insert the words "His excellency Tommy E. Remengesau, Jr. President of the Republic of Palau." So move, Mr. Speaker.

Members of the judiciary are here led by the Chief Justice and Judge Kim Tenorio and obviously the action we're about to take is going to send this bill to conference committee and prolong the process of addressing the issue we have down at the judicial branch. However, I would just like for the judiciary to know that the portion of the funding appropriation for the judiciary is untouched in this bill. However, because there is a significant change to other subsections of the bill and it requires that the conferees of both the House and the Senate iron out these differences before we can move this legislation

forward. So, we continue to ask the patience from the judiciary, but most of all the community who have to access the judicial services on a daily basis and continue to access these services from other temporary locations. Having said that Mr. Speaker, it is my hope that the conference committee will act expeditiously to reach a compromise on this particular legislation. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.
