


Dear Mr. Chairman and Mr. Speaker:

# A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$127,209.00 for the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301).

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

#### SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$127,209.00 from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301) and for other purposes.

#### **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.**

The Rota Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates \$127,209.00 from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under Business Unit 2301) for the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation for the student housing assistance. The Scholarship Board shall submit the list of students to receive the housing assistance to the Mayor of Rota, the expenditure authority, and the Mayor shall in turn provide the list to the Rota Resident Director of Finance for disbursements.

#### **SECTION 3. FISCAL YEAR.**

The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

#### SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or

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circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

#### SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

### SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
