

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301); and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO  
CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) from the Rota  
3 Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve Account (specifically under BU 2301) and for other  
4 purposes.

5 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.**

6           Notwithstanding 10 CMC §1901, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates  
7 sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) from the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation Reserve  
8 Account (specifically under Business Unit 2301) for the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation.  
9 The Expenditure Authority shall be the Chairman of the Rota Municipal Scholarship Foundation  
10 Board.



1 **SECTION 3. FISCAL YEAR.**

2 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

3 **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

4 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or  
5 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act  
6 or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held  
7 invalid shall not be affected thereby.


8 **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

9 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing  
10 right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or  
11 order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding  
12 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of  
13 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in  
14 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


15 **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

16 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without  
17 such approval.




