Dear Mr. Chairman and Mr. Speaker:

This is to inform you that I have signed into law **House Local Bill No. 23-28, S1**, entitled "To reappropriate Twenty-One Thousand Four Hundred and Forty-Eight Dollars (\$21,448.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04; and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-09; and for other purposes," which was passed by the Rota Legislative Delegation of the Twenty-Third Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature.

From the second constitutional convention in 1985 until HLI 10-8 in 1997, there was a constitutional legislative budget ceiling with a specified dollar amount.

HLI 10-8 changed the language to "the budget ceiling provided in this section" and provided a formula for calculation of the ceiling. The constitutional budget ceiling is now the aggregate of: \$150,000 per member; plus \$400,000 to the presiding officer for operations; plus \$2 million for the Legislative Bureau; all adjusted for inflation on a biannual basis from a baseline of January 1996 per the US DOC composite price index. *See* NMI CONST. art. II, § 16.

With 20 current House members, this yields a figure of \$5,400,000, adjusted for inflation from 1996 to 2022 to \$9,832,896.37.

The constitutional legislative budget ceiling is distinct from, and higher than, the amount appropriated for the legislature in the annual appropriations bill, in this instance \$6,791,324.

As the text of this bill notes, this is a re-appropriation of local funds by the local delegation pursuant to its powers under NMI CONST. art. II, § 6 and 1 CMC §§ 1402(b), 1403, and 1407.

This Bill becomes Rota Local Law 23-08. Copies bearing my signature are forwarded for your reference.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Five Thousand One Dollars (\$5,001.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04, § 2(d); Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$16,447.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04, § 2(c); and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) from Rota Local Law 22-09, § 2(a) for a combined total of Sixty-One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$61,448.00).

SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATIONS.

Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the contrary, the Rota Legislative Delegation hereby re-appropriates the combined total in the amount of Sixty-One

Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$61,448.00). from the following Rota Local Laws: Five Thousand One Dollars (\$5,001.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04, § 2(d); Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$16,447.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04, § 2(c); and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) from Rota Local Law 22-09, § 2(a) to the following:

- (a) Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) to the Office of the Mayor of Rota for personnel and operations.
- (b) Twenty-one thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$21,448.00) to the Rota Legislative Delegation. The justification for this appropriation is based on the following:

The funds re-appropriated under this subsection are strictly local funds of the First Senatorial, not General Funds. Therefore, this re-appropriation of the local funds is not part of the FY 2024 Budget Act. Accordingly, this re-appropriation of local funds does not contravene 1 CMC § 7401 and 1 CMC § 7204(d).

SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2 (a) shall be the Mayor of Rota and funds under Section 2 (b) shall be the Chairman of the Rota Legislative Delegation.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without such approval.

II. ANALYSIS:

A. Purpose:

The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Five Thousand One Dollars (\$5,001.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04, §2(d); Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$16,447.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04, §2(c); and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) from Rota Local Law 22-09, §2(a) for a combined total of Sixty-One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$61,448.00) for the following:

- (1) Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) to the Office of the Mayor of Rota for personnel and operations.
- (2) Twenty-One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$21,448.00) to the Rota Legislative Delegation.

B. Committee Findings:

Your Committee on Ways and Means to which House Local Bill No. 23-28: "To re-appropriate Twenty-One Thousand Four Hundred and Forty-Eight Dollars (\$21,448.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04; and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-09; and for other purposes." was referred to verify and confirm that the amount specified in the local appropriation Act is accurate and available for appropriation. The Committee received the Fund Certification as of August 28, 2023 that was verified and approved by the Secretary of Finance, Mrs. Tracy B. Norita, certifying that Rota Local Law 22-04, §2(d), specifically under BU 2204R, has a remaining balance of \$5,001.00; that Rota Local Law 22-04, §2(c), specifically under BU 2701R, has a remaining balance of \$16,447.38; and that Rota Local Law 22-09, §2(a), specifically under BU 2701G, has a remaining balance of \$150,000.00; that is available for appropriation.

Therefore, the Committee recommends that House Local Bill No. 23-28 be transmitted to the Rota Legislative Delegation for action. Department of Finance Fund Certification as of August 28, 2023 has been attached as part of this committee report.

C. Legislative History:

House Local Bill 23-28 was introduced by Representative Julie Marie A. Ogo on September 7, 2023 and was subsequently referred to the House Standing Committee on Ways and Means for disposition.
