#### **SECTION 5. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.**

Expenditures of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be responsible to report all expenses to the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of the funds. Provided further that failure to provide all expenses, entities that were afforded funds under this Act shall not be able to avail to any future funds appropriated by the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose and

notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this Act shall be without fiscal

#### SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.

Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

#### **SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

#### **SECTION 8. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or

order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

#### 1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

- Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the

- 7 and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby repeals and reenacts
- 8 Section 2(t)(1) of Saipan Local Law No. 20-26, to read as follows:

begs leave to report as follows:

#### I. RECOMMENDATION:

After conducting financial due diligence, your committee recommends that House Local Bill No. 23-16 be transmitted to the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation for action.

#### II. ANALYSIS:

#### A. Purpose:

To repeal and reenact Section 2(t)(1) of Saipan Local Law No. 20-26 to fund non-profit organizations and provide funding for the renovation and construction of pavilions, recreational areas and public buildings in Precinct IV.

#### B. Committee Findings:

Your Committee on Ways and Means to which House Local Bill No. 23-16: "To repeal and reenact Section 2(t)(1) of Saipan Local Law No. 20-26 to fund non-profit organizations and provide funding for the renovation and construction of pavilions, recreational areas and public buildings in Precinct IV; and for other purposes." was referred to verify and confirm that the amount specified in the local appropriation Act is accurate and available for appropriation. Prior to the enactment of Saipan Local Law 20-26, the certification of funds was made available to the Members and were informed that the funds were available. Therefore, the Committee recommends that House Local Bill No. 23-16 be transmitted to the Saipan and Northern Island Legislative Delegation for action.

#### C. Legislative History:

House Local Bill 23-16 was introduced by Representative Joel C. Camacho and Representative Malcolm Omar on June 20, 2023 and was subsequently referred to the House Standing Committee on Ways and Means for disposition.

#### III. CONCLUSION:

The Committee is content and confident with the prior certification of funds with respect to House Local Bill No. 23-16, and therefore recommends that it be transmitted to the Saipan and Northern Island Legislative Delegation for action.
