A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To re-appropriate funds under Saipan Local Law 22-08; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The Delegation finds that Section 2(A) of Saipan Local Law 22-8 appropriated One Million US Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to the Northern Marianas College (NMC), unfortunately the funds were not remitted to the Northern Marianas College (NMC). Furthermore, the Delegation finds that Saipan Local Law 23-2 appropriated the same amount to the Northern Marianas College (NMC) to address the needs of the Northern Marianas College (NMC) campus so that the Northern Marianas College (NMC) can proceed forward with its project in building a new state of the art campus for its students and visitors. Therefore, the intent of this Act is to re-appropriate the One Million US Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) under Section 2(A) of Saipan Local Law 22-8 pursuant to Public Law 20-10.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the contrary the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby re-appropriates One Million US Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from Section 2(A) of Saipan Local Law 22-8 pursuant to Public Law 20-10 as follows:

- A) \$50,000.00 for Karidat for its personnel/operations within the Third Senatorial District, expenditure authority shall be the Executive Director of Karidat or his/her designee;
- B) \$50,000.00 for Center of Living Independently (CLI) for its personnel/operations within the Third Senatorial District, expenditure authority shall be the Executive Director of CLI or his/her designee;
- C) \$100,000.00 for Substance Abuse and Recovery (SAAR) for its personnel/operations within the Third Senatorial District, expenditure authority shall be the Executive Director of SAAR or his/her designee;
- D) \$20,000.00 for the Department of Public Works for its operations (fuel and lubricant), expenditure authority shall be the Secretary of DPW or his/her designee;
- E) \$10,000.00 for the Kagman Agricultural Farms and Producers Association Inc., expenditure authority shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee;
- F) \$15,000.00 for the Northern Mariana Islands Basketball Federation (NMIBF), expenditure authority shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee;

U) \$50,000.00 for the Micronesian Legal Services Corporation (MLSC) for maintenance and services within the Third Senatorial District, expenditure shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee.

SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.

Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

SECTION 4. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.

Expenditure authorities of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be responsible to report all expenses and provide all supporting documents to include but not be limited to receipt and invoices to the Secretary of the Department of Finance and the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation by the end of the 2023 calendar year. Provided further that failure to provide all expenses entities that were afforded funds under this Act shall not be able to avail to any future funds appropriated by the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held

invalid shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without such approval.
