This is to inform you that I have signed into law **House Local Bill No. 24-15**, entitled "To appropriate revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 20-59.", which was passed by the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation of the Twenty-Fourth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature.

Public Law 20-59 repealed and reenacted 4 CMC § 1508 such that the first \$11,300,000.00 of revenues generated from amusement machine licensing under 4 CMC § 1503(a)(2) and (a)(5) would "be deposited into the Third Senatorial District Delegation account and made available for appropriation by the Third Senatorial District Delegation." As then envisioned, those moneys were to be used to fund adjustments in the salary scale for government employees enacted by Public Law 07-31.

Following the first \$11,300,000.00, subsequent revenues generated by poker and pachinko machine licenses pursuant to 4 CMC § 1503(a)(2) and (a)(5) were to be deposited "in a separate trust account in the General Fund to be known as the 'Capital Building Trust Fund.'" These moneys would thus be Commonwealth-wide funds and not subject to appropriation by the SNILD.

As a subsequent enactment, House Local Bill No. 24-15 contains a clause providing that it is enacted "[n]otwithstanding any provision(s) of law . . . to the contrary," such that it frees funds the provided for in Public Law 20-59 from restrictions in that legislation.

I caution, however, that the current account for 4 CMC § 1503(a)(2) and (a)(5) was opened in Fiscal Year 2021, whereas Public Law 20-59 was enacted in 2018, such that it is difficult to readily ascertain whether the \$11,300,000.00 threshold was met.

This bill becomes **Saipan Local Law No. 24-09**. Copies bearing my signature are forwarded for your reference.

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 20-59.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate local funds from the revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 20-59.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Third Senatorial District the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby appropriates \$230,000.00 of the revenues collected for the Third Senatorial District pursuant to Public Law 20-59 as follows:

HOUSE LOCAL BILL No. 24-15

(A) \$150,000.00 to support the operations of the Pacific Behavior Center for healthcare and mental health services that are made equally available to the entire community, expenditure authority under 2(A) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee;

- (B) \$5,000.00 to support the operations of the Marianas Business Network to provide services that support and promote small businesses and economic opportunities in the CNMI and are made equally available to the entire community, expenditure authority under 2(B) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee;
- (C) \$40,000.00 for the operations of the Saipan Humane Society, expenditure authority under 2(C) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee; and
- (D) \$35,000.00 for the operations of the Northern Marianas Protection & Advocacy Systems, Inc. (NMPASI), expenditure authority under 2(D) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance or his/her designee.

SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.

Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose and notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

SECTION 4. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.

Expenditure authorities of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be responsible to report all expenses to the Secretary of the Department of Finance and the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation by the end of the 2025 calendar year. Provided further, that any entity that fails to report all expenditures of funds received



under this Act shall be ineligible to receive future appropriations from the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without such approval.
