

### A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$380,000.00 from revenues collected pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

#### SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate local funds from the revenues collected pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06.

#### SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules, or regulations to the contrary, and pursuant to funds allocated to the Third Senatorial District, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby appropriates \$380,000 of the revenues collected pursuant to Saipan Local Law 22-06, as amended, as follows:

(A) \$200,000.00 to Karidat for its personnel/operations to cover the grant obligations from CJPA that is currently on hold due to the delay of CNMI's single audit; expenditure authority shall

be the Executive Director of Karidat or his/her designee. Provided, however, that should the grant funding for Karidat under CJPA be available, Karidat shall first reimburse the \$200,000.00 to the account of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation;

- (B) \$60,000.00 for the Navy Hill Basketball rehabilitation, expenditure authority shall be the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation or his/her designee;
- (C) \$50,000.00 for the CNMI Scholarship and Financial Assistance Office, expenditure authority shall be the Chairperson of the Board or his/her designee;
- (D) \$30,000.00 for the operations of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation, expenditure authority shall be the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation;
- (E) \$20,000.00 for the Carolinian Affairs Office for Cultural Heritage Month and related operational expenses, expenditure authority shall be the Chairperson of the Carolinian Advisory Council or his/her designee; and
- (F) \$20,000.00 for the Indigenous Affairs Office for Cultural Heritage Month and related operational expenses, expenditure authority shall be the Resident Executive of the Indigenous Affairs Office or his/her designee.

#### **SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.**

Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all funds appropriated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

#### SECTION 4. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.

Those responsible for the expenditure of funds allocated under section 2 of this act shall report all expenses to the Secretary of the Department of Finance by the end of the 2026 calendar

year. Furthermore, should they fail to provide a full accounting of expenses, entities (government, non-profit entities, etc., excluding specific projects) that received funds under this act shall be ineligible for any future funds appropriated by the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

#### **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

#### SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

#### **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
