BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT

TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds specifically allotted under 4 CMC §

3 2307(b) for personnel, public programs, operations, and professional services of the Second

5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

Notwithstanding any provision, statutes, laws or regulations to the contrary, the Tinian
and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates the amount of One Million US
Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) of the funds allotted to the Second Senatorial District under 4 CMC §
2307(b) as follows:

(a) For personnel, operations, public programs, and professional

6	SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.
7	The expenditure authority for the funds appropriated under this Act shall be as follows:

9	Tinian shall be the expenditure authority.
10	(b) For the funds appropriated under Section 2(b) of this Act, the Chairman of the
11	Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation shall be the expenditure authority.
12	SECTION 4. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.
13	(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Secretary of the Department of
14	Finance shall transfer the funds appropriated under Section 2(a) and (c) within 15 calendar
15	days of the effective date of this Act to an account set up by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer.

2 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it
is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

7 SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

8 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any 9 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, 10 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect 11 any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not 12 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which 13 shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
