

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$124,000.00 from revenues collected from poker fees in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

- 2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate One Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand dollars
- 3 (\$124,000.00 USD) from revenues collected from poker fees in the Second Senatorial District.
- 4 The certification of funds was prepared on June 1, 2023 and was reviewed and confirmed by the
- 5 Acting Secretary of Finance.

6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

- Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the contrary and
- 8 pursuant to funds allocated to the Second Senatorial District from poker fees, the Tinian and
- 9 Aguiguan Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates \$124,000.00 of the revenues collected for
- the Second Senatorial District from the poker fees as follows:

HOUSE LOCAL BILL 23-13, D1

- 1 (A) \$24,000.00 to the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for discretionary account; and
- 2 (B) \$100,000.00 to the Tinian Casino Gaming Control Commission for personnel.

3 SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

- The expenditure authority for funds under Section 2 shall be the Mayor of Tinian and
- 5 Aguiguan.

6 SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.

- Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose and
- 8 notwithstanding any provision of law, all funds appropriated under this Act shall be without fiscal
- 9 year limitation(s).

SECTION 5. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.

- The recipient of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be responsible to
- report all expenses to the Secretary of the Department of Finance by the end of the 2023 calendar
- 13 year. Provided further that failure to provide all expenses, entities that were afforded funds under
- 14 this Act shall not be able to avail to any future funds appropriated by the Tinian & Aguiguan
- 15 Legislative Delegation.

16 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

- 17 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
- circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act
- or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held
- 20 invalid shall not be affected thereby.

21 SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

HOUSE LOCAL BILL 23-13, D1

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in

existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Your Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred:

House Local Bill No. 23-13: "To appropriate \$124,000.00 from revenues collected from poker fees in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes."

begs leave to report as follows:

I. RECOMMENDATION:

After conducting financial due diligence, your committee recommends that House Local Bill No. 23-13 be transmitted to the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation for action.

II. ANALYSIS:

A. Purpose:

To appropriate \$124,000,00 from revenues collected from poker fees in the Second Senatorial District IV.

B. Committee Findings:

Your Committee on Ways and Means to which House Local Bill No. 23-13: "To appropriate \$124,000.00 from revenues collected from poker fees in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes." was referred to verify and confirm that the amount specified in the local appropriation Act is accurate and available for appropriation. The Committee was provided with the Certification – Second Senatorial District Poker Fees dated June 1, 2023 from the Office of the Secretary, Department of Finance (SFL 2023-579), certifying the availability of these funds, therefore, the Committee recommends that House Local Bill No. 23-13 be transmitted to the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation for action. SFL 2023-579, FY2023 Local Poker Fee Collection as of 05/31/2023 Tinian and the Account Ledger Inquiry have been attached as part of this committee report.

C. Legislative History:

House Local Bill 23-13 was introduced by Representative Patrick H. San Nicolas on June 20, 2023 and was subsequently referred to the House Standing Committee on Ways and Means for disposition.

III. CONCLUSION:

The Committee is content and confident with the certification of funds provided by the Acting Secretary of Finance with respect to House Local Bill No. 23-13, and therefore recommends that it be transmitted to the Tinian and Aguiguan Legislative Delegation for action.
