AN ACT

TO AMEND 1 CMC SECTION 1402 (A) TO PERMIT SENATORIAL DISTRICTS TO CREATE AND REGULATE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS OR CIDS.

The Bill was referred to the House Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations, which submitted Standing Committee Report 21-35; adopted 10/15/2019.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, OCTOBER 15, 2019; without amendments and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was referred to the Senate Committee on Judiciary, Government, Law and Federal Relations, which submitted Standing Committee Report 21-84; adopted 3/13/2020. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, MARCH 13, 2020; with amendments in the form of H. B. No. 21-68, SD1.

H. B. No. 21-68, SD1, WAS RETURNED TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON APRIL 16, 2020.

The House of Representatives accepted the Senate amendments and passed H. B. No. 21-68, SD1, during its First Day, Second Special Session on May 21, 2020.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON MAY 21, 2020.

AN ACT

TO AMEND 1 CMC SECTION 1402 (A) TO PERMIT SENATORIAL DISTRICTS TO CREATE AND REGULATE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS OR CIDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TWENTY-FIRST NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.

The Legislature finds that certain tourism areas in Garapan and other tourist-frequented areas in the Commonwealth should be better and more holistically managed to provide a better overall cultural and commercial environment for present and future generations of locals and tourists alike. In pursuing this policy, these specific areas, such as the tourist-frequented areas in Garapan will be subject to rules and regulations in areas called Community Improvement Districts or CIDs that will both enhance existing features and create new attractions that will be traditional, commercially feasible, and aesthetically pleasing.

Title 1 Section 1402 (a) of the Commonwealth Code expressly lists subjects or matters within which a senatorial district may enact local laws. Subsection (a) defines a local bill as a

bill that "if enacted, becomes a law pertaining exclusively to matters within one senatorial district".

Because Article II, section 6 of the CNMI Constitution allows for a Senatorial District to legislate within the district, the Legislature hereby deems it important to add to the list set forth in 1 CMC section 1402 (a) to include the establishment and regulation of Community Improvement Districts or CIDs.

Accordingly, this Act, is hereby enacted to allow all CNMI Senatorial Districts to enact regulations and laws within their municipalities that are needed to establish these CIDs for the purpose of creating a better overall business and tourist friendly experience.

SECTION 2. <u>AMENDMENT</u>.

Title 1, Division 1, Chapter 4, Enactment of Local Laws, section 1402 (a) Definitions of the Commonwealth Code is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection (20) that shall read as follows:

"(20) The establishment and regulation of Community Improvement Districts or CIDs that enhance existing features or create new attractions within a district established by local law or regulations. The purpose of establishing a CIDs is to improve the community through infrastructure investment and creating conditions that attract new growth. CIDs may include capital improvements, beautification, community safety, business retention and economic development.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 4. <u>SAVINGS CLAUSE</u>.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not

have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
