## AN ACT

### TO RE-APPROPRIATE FUNDS UNDER SECTION 2(G) OF PUBLIC LAW 20-61 FOR THE HEALTH NETWORK PROGRAM (HNP); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE TWENTY-THIRD NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

#### SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.

The Legislature finds that the Office of Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) under the Executive Branch has identified funds for the architectural and engineering design, and construction of a solid waste transfer station for the southern part of Saipan. The Legislature further finds that Section 2(g) of Public Law 20-61 appropriated One Million Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,085,000.00) for the exact same project.

Additionally, the Legislature finds that the Health Network Program (HNP) under the Commonwealth Health Care Corporation (CHCC) is in dire need of additional funds to assist patients from the Commonwealth seeking medical assistance/treatment outside of the Commonwealth. The Legislature finds that it is imperative that the House, Senate and the Administration work harmoniously to find funds to assist the HNP and CHCC to continue these
