The Senate of the Twelfth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature, First Day, Fourth Special Session, 2000, was called to order at 10:10 a.m. in the Senate Chamber on Capitol Hill, Saipan, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

The Honorable Paul A. Manglona, President of the Senate, presided.

President Manglona: Thank you. We have the necessary quorum to conduct today's business.

Section 3. <u>Amendment.</u> Public Law 10-38, Section 3(b) as amended by Public Law 11-7, is further amended to read as follows:

"(b) First Senatorial District.

(1)\$1,700,00 for A&E and construction of <u>JROTC</u> and <u>vocational/educational</u> facilities, at <u>Tatachog</u>, for use by the <u>Northern Marianas College</u>. A vocational shop and <u>JROTC</u> classrooms including storage rooms at the Rota High.

(2)\$2,283,375 for A&E, construction and paving of village roads in Songsong and Sinapalo villages.

Notwithstanding any other section of this Act, expenditure authority for projects under this paragraph shall be vested in the Secretary of Public Works and the Mayor of Rota and no others. Delegation appropriations pursuant to this section are exempt from the limitations of 1 CMC §1402(b), but shall conform to 1 CMC §7103(g)."

3. Renumber existing Sections 3, 4, and 5 to be Sections 4, 5, and 6.
